DDOT Approves Saturday Work Hours on the Cleveland Park Streetscape And Drainage Improvement Project

(Washington, DC) — The District Department of Transportation (DDOT) has approved extended work hours on the Cleveland Park Streetscape and Drainage Improvement Project.

As a part of DDOT's commitment to advancing the streetscape and drainage improvement along the project corridor, the contractor is authorized to work on Saturdays beginning April 16, 2022, between the hours of 7:00 AM and 7:00 PM. Contractor will work with the community to ensure that weekend construction activities minimally impact Cleveland Park activities.

Traffic controls will be in place to guide motorists, cyclists, and pedestrians safely through the work zone. All users of the roadway are advised to stay alert, be observant of signage and expect delays while traveling in this area.
