STREETSCAPE AND DRAINAGE IMPROVEMENT PROJECT

Dear Stakeholder:

The District Department of Transportation (DDOT) would like to extend its appreciation for your patience and understanding, while we are working on the Cleveland Park Streetscape and Drainage project. The purpose of this project is to improve local recurring flooding problems near the Cleveland Park Metro Station, improve vehicular, cyclist and pedestrian safety, and implement several green infrastructure improvements along the Connecticut Avenue corridor.

As part of the Cleveland Park Streetscape and Drainage project, on Saturday, July 8th, weather permitting, the contractor will begin paving the sidewalk at Connecticut Ave NW and Ordway St NW. The purpose of the paving is to repair damage that occurred during pole bracing. The sidewalk will be closed, and detours put in place during this time. This work will last approximately 2 days.

Traffic controls will be in place to guide motorists, cyclists and pedestrians safely around the work zone. All users of the roadway are advised to stay alert, be observant of signage and expect delays while traveling in this area.
