STREETSCAPE AND DRAINAGE IMPROVEMENT PROJECT

Dear Stakeholder:

The District Department of Transportation (DDOT) would like to extend its appreciation for your patience and understanding, while we are working on the Cleveland Park Streetscape and Drainage project. The purpose of this project is to improve local recurring flooding problems near the Cleveland Park Metro Station, improve vehicular, cyclist and pedestrian safety, and implement several green infrastructure improvements along the Connecticut Avenue corridor.

This project is located along Connecticut Avenue from Macomb Street NW to Quebec Street NW and each adjoining street. The construction project began on March 21, 2022, and the anticipated completion is Fall 2023, weather permitting. The Contractor is authorized to work between 7:00 am and 7:00 pm, Monday through Friday and occasional Saturdays. Lane closures on Connecticut Avenue are permitted between 9:30 am and 3:30 pm Monday through Friday.

As part of the Cleveland Park Streetscape and Drainage project, on Monday, November 28, weather permitting, the contractor will begin demolition of existing sidewalk along the Southbound side of Connecticut Ave, installing new sidewalk, cobblestone, edging and base. This work will last approximately 6-8 weeks.

Traffic controls will be in place to guide motorists, cyclists and pedestrians safely around the work zone. All users of the roadway are advised to stay alert, be observant of signage and expect delays while traveling in this area.
